

The Water Trail

155 miles of boatable rivers.

Come on one of WWALS' monthly one-day paddle outings!

Most upstream are Ray City Landing at mile 98 on GA 37 on the 115-mile **Withlacoochee River** and Kinard Bridge Road at mile 57.5 on for the 105-mile **Little River**.

Craft your own trip up to a week long and 120.7 miles: 57.5 miles down the Little River, then 63.2 miles down the Withlacoochee River to the **Suwannee River**.

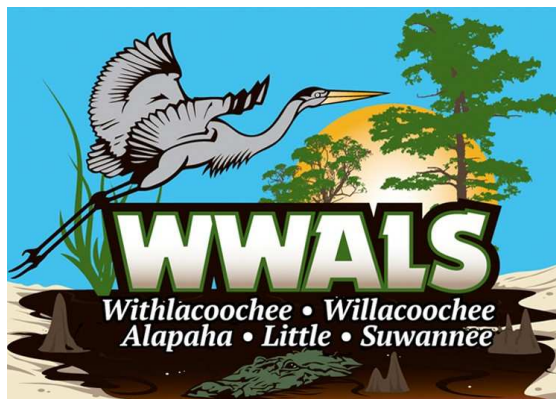

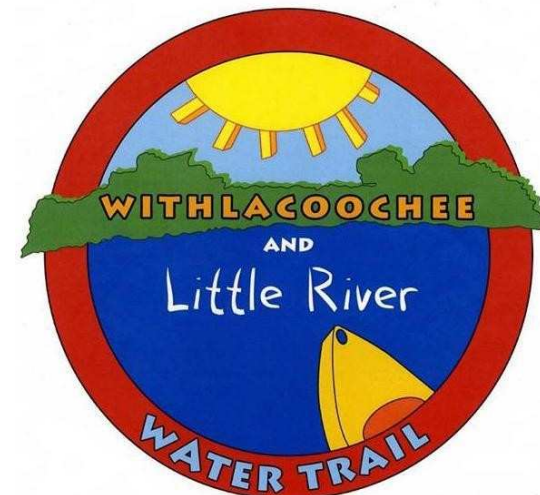

One of the few undammed U.S. rivers!

The **Withlacoochee River** flows in its unruly tea-colored blackwater splendor past cypress, river birch, oaks, pines, herons, turtles, and alligators over south Georgia shoals, by Madison Blue Spring State Park in north Florida, down to the Suwannee River.



The **Little River** at Reed Bingham State Park (RBSP) (pictured) floats the annual WWALS BIG Little River Paddle Race. Undammed below RBSP, the Little River joins the Withlacoochee outside Valdosta in Lowndes County, the largest Suwannee Basin population center.

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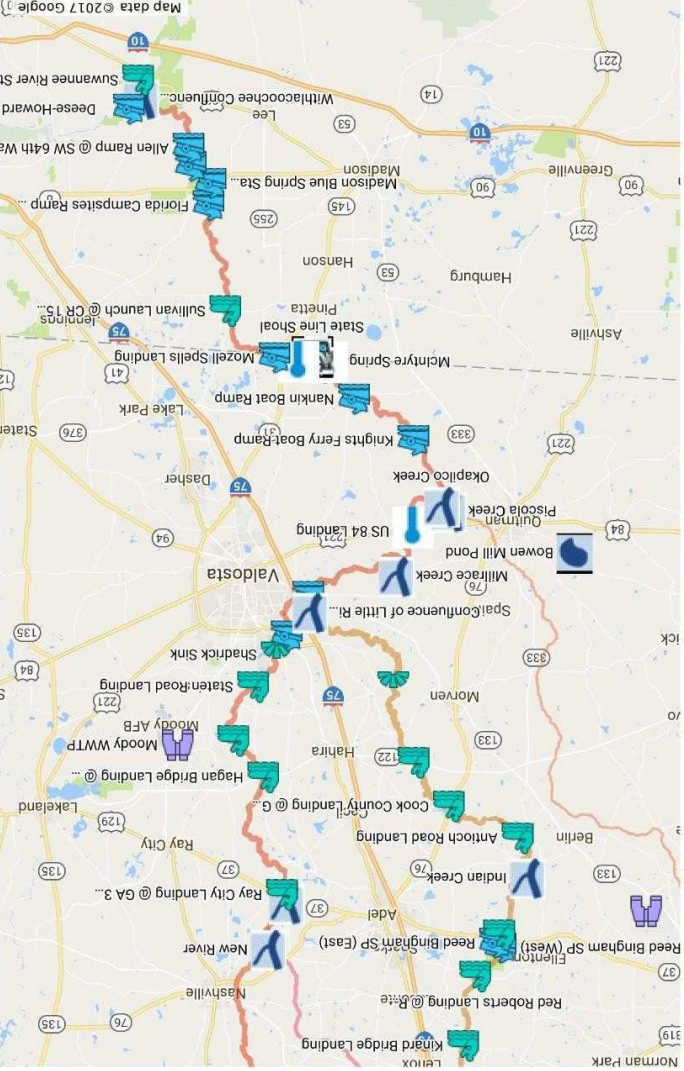


4. Be extremely careful with campfires.
