On February 2, 2016, as amended, reinstated and extended,<sup>1</sup> the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC” or “Commission”) granted Sabal Trail Transmission, LLC (“Sabal Trail”) certificates of public convenience and necessity, among other authorizations, to construct and operate the Sabal Trail Project (“Project”). On October 31, 2018, Sabal Trail filed its final monthly status report, which reflected activity through September 30, 2018. The final monthly report indicated that Sabal Trail would begin providing quarterly reports until all restoration activities for the Phase I Facilities had been completed.

Sabal Trail hereby submits its first quarterly status report on restoration activities for the Phase I Project facilities for the period October 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.
