**TASK SUMMARY  
For the Period of October 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018**

**CURRENT AND UPCOMING ACTIVITIES**

***Clean-up, Restoration, and Punchlist Items***

- Continuing to monitor re-vegetation success across the Project rights-of-way. A re-vegetation progress table and restoration photographs are appended to this report.
- Sabal Trail's specialty seeding contractor continues to address areas along the entire pipeline route where upland vegetation had not achieved the desired percent coverage. Treatment of these areas will resume when growth conditions permit in 2019.
- Environmental inspectors and biological monitors continue to monitor nuisance and exotic plant species in wetlands and uplands. Herbicide treatments continued through November and will be restarted as necessary once the growing season starts in 2019.
- Environmental inspectors continue to monitor the construction right-of-way for post construction issues and stormwater controls and best management practices in accordance with permit requirements.
- Crews continue to complete individual or punch list items previously identified. As new items are identified, either through monitoring or landowner contact, they are prioritized, addressed, and tracked until resolved.

- Additional post construction cleanup was conducted at the Hunters Creek M&R Station. Restoration is ongoing and should be complete when the growing season resumes in 2019.
- Restoration is ongoing at the FGT Suwannee M&R Station and should be complete when the growing season resumes in 2019.
