Additional Information: 9CR207 represents the remains of an early-to-middle 20th century collection of domestic structures adjacent to SR 94 approximately 3.75 miles west of St. George, GA. The site has experienced decades of intensive silviculture that obliterated structural remains and scattered material over a roughly 18,0000 m² area. The site boundary is defined by the extent of cultural material scattered upon the surface. Two areas of high density scatter were shovel tested at 10m intervals to determine if subsurface features remained. A roughly 10 percent sample of cultural material, mostly glass and whiteware, was collected for analysis. The site is not recommended eligible for NRHP inclusion, given its lack of integrity and data potential
