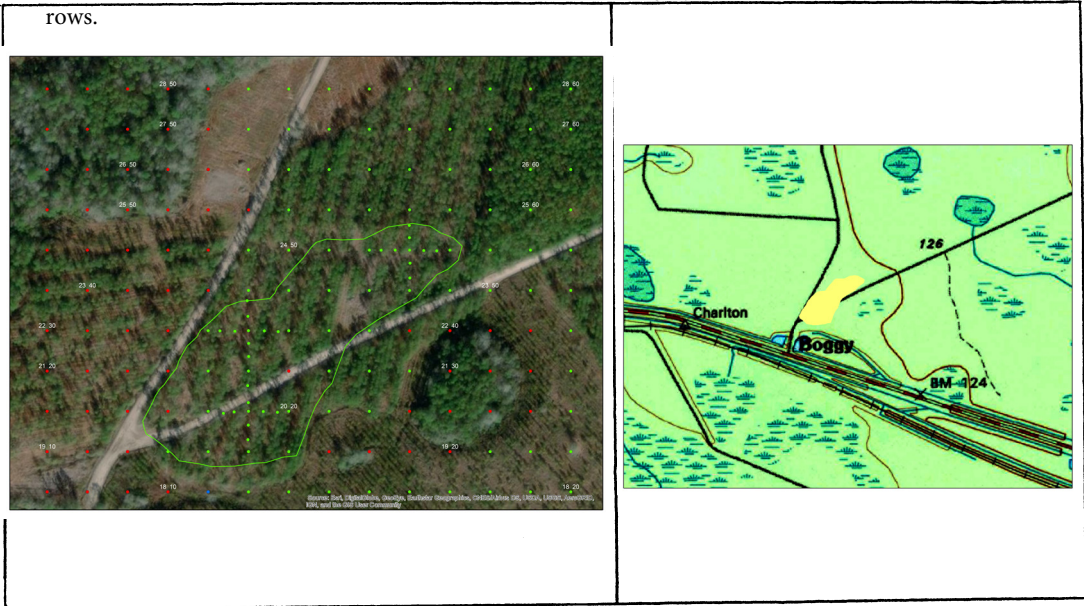

Additional Information: Site consists of a large scatter of early 20th century historic materials on the surface of a planted pine field that is bisected by Angle Road. Historic topo maps depicts structures at this area titled as Olivers Mill. No standing architecture was observed. No artifacts were found in subsurface contexts. While the extent of the scatter is large, two areas with a denser concentration of artifacts were tested at 10 meter intervals (see map). Extent of the scatter roughly follows the orientation of planted pine
