WWALS Watershed Coalition Banks Lake Solstice Light Parade 41590-21-008 December 19, 2020

The USFWS may revoke this permit due to unsatisfactory compliance with refuge regulations. You are responsible for the behavior of all group members.

Group leader must carry a copy of this permit (and any other required permits) at all times when on refuge property.

This permit allows you access only to areas normally open to the public, during posted hours.

All gear and supplies are subject to inspection by Federal and State law enforcement officers.

You may not leave any items/flagging/etc on the refuge.

This permit does not give you higher priority than the general visitor. The dock/boat ramp are open on a first come first serve basis. There may be anglers using the dock/boat ramp. Permittee will be courteous to the general public and answer questions professionally as to their activities.

Disturbance to wildlife will be kept to a minimum.

Noise will be minimal as to not disturb other users and nearby residences.

No fireworks or loud horns will be allowed.

Spot lights will be used only for safety purposes.
