This letter is in reference to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA)¹ request filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission) on October 23, 2020. We have determined that in order to respond to your request, Commission staff must consult with other components of the agency having substantial subject-matter interest therein. *See* 18 C.F.R. § 388.110(b)(1) and (b)(4)(iii) (2020).
