- c. At minimum monitoring activities should also be audited annually to ensure that quality standards are met. Results should be published on the web, not just via USB stick.
 - d. A quality assurance and control plan for water quality monitoring should be made publicly available: on the web, not just via USB stick.
4. I request that Hamilton BOCC require Nutrien to state its future expansion plans, whether across the Suwannee River into Columbia County, or across the state line into Echols County, Georgia, or elsewhere. If Nutrien has no such plans, let them say so plainly in the Public Hearing.
 5. I request that Hamilton BOCC require Nutrien to explain who will be responsible for gypstacks and reclaimed areas after Nutrien ceases operations.
