ORDINANCE NUMBER 2023-8

AN ORDINANCE OF LEVY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE RELATING TO FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION – CUMULATIVE SUBSTANTIAL IMPROVEMENTS; BY AMENDING SECTION 50-131 TO ADOPT LOCAL TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS TO THE FLORIDA BUILDING CODE; BY AMENDING SECTION 50-228 DEFINITIONS; AND BY AMENDING SECTION 50-246 DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATOR; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING DIRECTIONS TO THE COUNTY COORDINATOR; AND PROVIDING DIRECTIONS TO THE CLERK AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A copy of the ordinance may be inspected by any member of the public at the Office of the Board of County Commissioners located at 310 School Street, Bronson, Florida, during regular business hours. All interested persons may appear and be heard at the public hearings. The meeting may be continued to one or more future dates. Any interested party shall be advised that the date, time and place of any continuation of this meeting shall be announced during the public hearing and no further notice regarding these matters will be published, unless said continuation exceeds six calendar weeks from the above referenced meeting. All persons are advised that, if they decide to appeal any decision made at a public hearing, they will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, they may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
