Waterbody Name refers to the name of the river, creek or other waterbody being nominated. Please reference waterbody names as recognized in the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) national hydrography dataset (NHD) that are viewable on the USGS National Map Viewer (https://apps.nationalmap.gov/viewer/). An organization wishing to nominate a water trail that includes a main river and portions of several tributaries must submit a separate nomination for each named waterbody associated with that trail.
 Waterbody Description: Withlacoochee River - GA 37 to Tiger Creek Waterbody description should include starting (upstream) and ending (downstream) boundaries for the segment. Road crossings, creeks, lakes, and other waterbodies that merge or intersect with the nominated waterbody are preferred boundaries. Examples: Chattahoochee River - Snake Creek to Yellowdirt Creek Broad River - Wildcat Bridge Rd. to Scull Shoal Creek Withlacoochee River - Tiger Creek to State Line EPD can help nominators select landmarks for waterbody descriptions if needed. EPD may amend the description provided by nominators for consistency with the format in the Rules. One waterbody (river) per nomination
