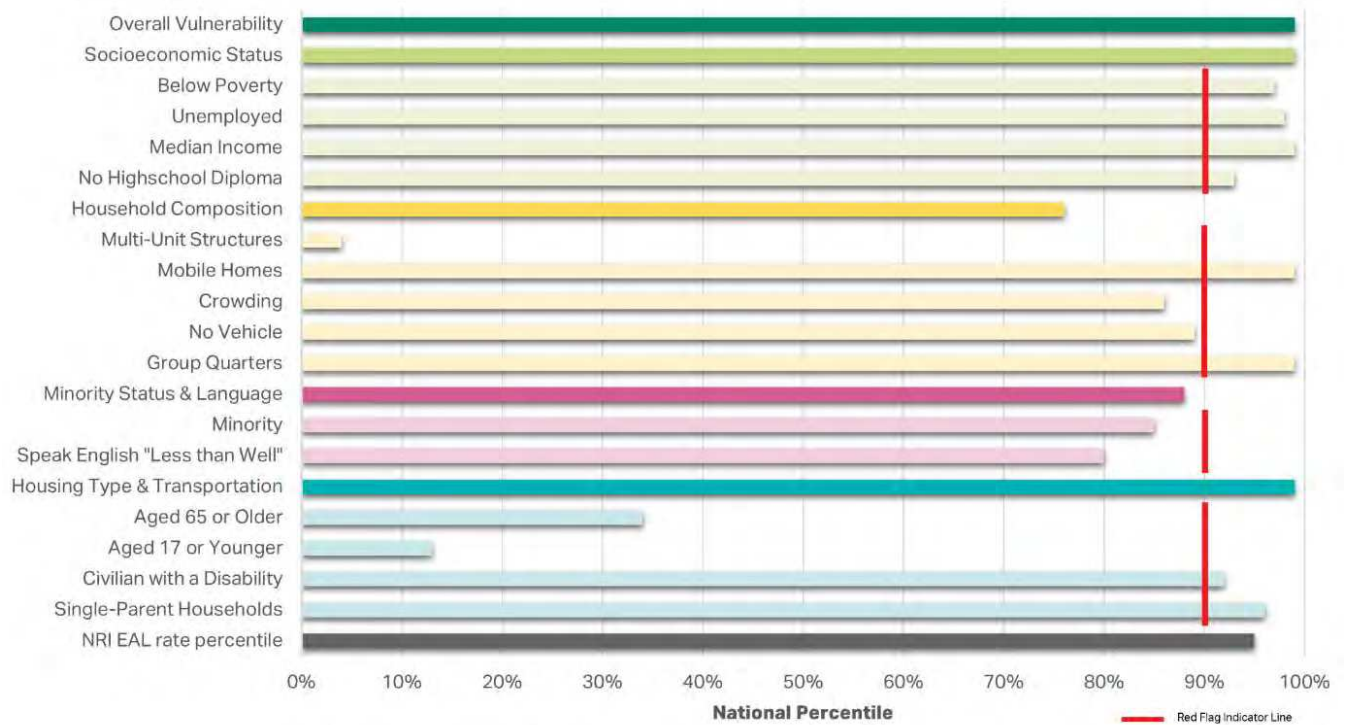


Figure 4 – Example of Social Vulnerability Index 15 categories
