DOH-Madison Lifts Water Quality Health Advisory for Withlacoochee River

Madison, Fla. — The Florida Department of Health in Madison County (DOH-Madison) is lifting the advisory for high bacterial levels in the Withlacoochee River.

Tests completed on Friday, November 15, 2024, and Monday, November 18, 2024, indicate that the water quality at the Withlacoochee River show an acceptable level of *Enterococcus* bacteria established by state guidelines.
