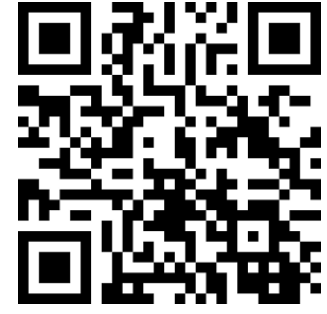

After rains, you can see countless gushing streams, many of them waterfalls. Any time, there are black rocks and a fallen island. Watch for the Halberdleaf Rosemallow. Across the GA-FL line there are very nice rapids. Paddle up the Alapahoochee River to see Turket Falls!

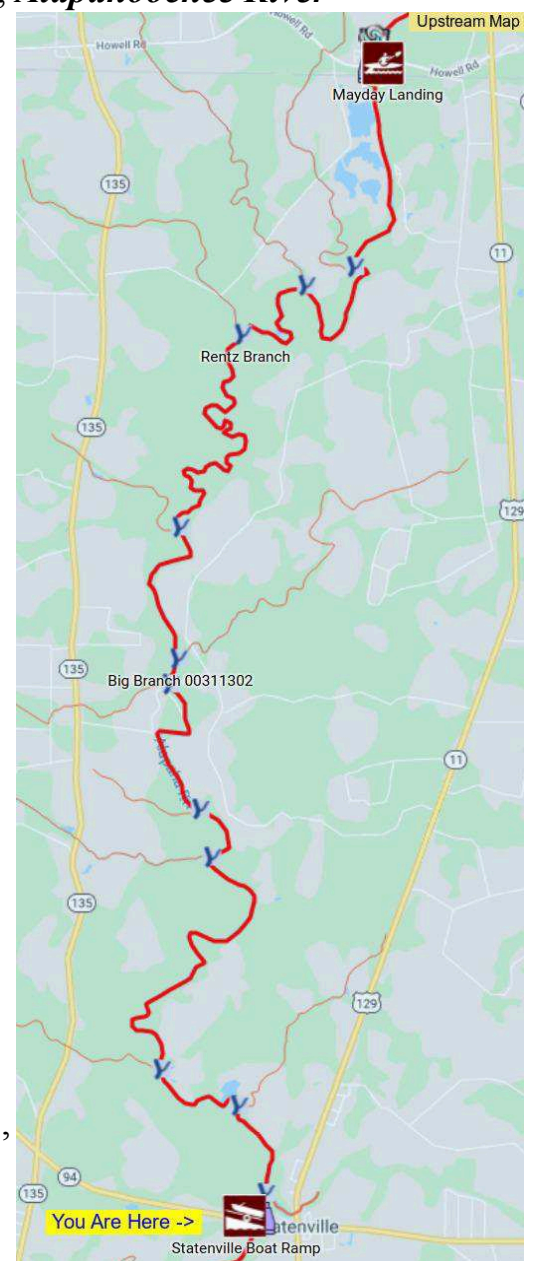
