Based on the current project requirements FDOT and its contractors would need to source approximately 4.5 million cubic yards of fill material within 5 miles of the project limits. Currently the land development code and zoning requirements (including 500' setback and Public Hearing/Meeting requirements) make this task unattainable within the project schedule and would lead to further project delays. FDOT is seeking Citrus County's assistance in creating an environment that allows our Contractors to source mines/borrow pits within our project area as defined above.

Suggested parameters:

- Within 5 miles of project limits
- No local permit required
- Duration: During the Suncoast Parkway Extension project
- Material only to be used for Suncoast Parkway Extension project
