

1 (A) The County may from time to time by
2 resolution adopted by the Board of County
3 Commissioners impose reasonable fees to be
4 charged for access to or certain uses of
5 any park or recreational facility.

6 (B) To the extent necessary to enhance the
7 public's use or enjoyment of a park or
8 recreational facility, the County may from
9 time to time by resolution adopted by the
10 Board of County Commissioners collect
11 reasonable fees for parking at any park or
12 recreational facility.

13 (C) To maintain the public's reasonable access
14 to and enjoyment of park or recreational
15 facilities, regular commercial uses of
16 parks or recreational facilities shall
17 require issuance of an annual permit
18 through the office of the County Parks and
19 Recreation Director.

20 a. "Regular commercial use" means usage of
21 any park or recreational facility or
22 part thereof for any commercial purpose
23 more than six times in any 12-month
24 period.
