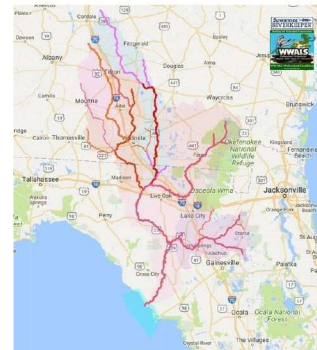


Fifth Annual Suwannee RIVERKEEPER® Songwriting Contest



Finals: August 20, 2022, Valdosta, Georgia

Songs: about the Suwannee River or its tributaries the Little, Black, or Gopher, the Withlacoochee or its tributaries the Little or New, the Alapaha or its tributaries the Alapahoochee, Willacoochee, Little, Alapaha, or Dead, or other Rivers, creeks, springs, sinks, swamps, or ponds in the Suwannee River Basin or Estuary. (But not the Santa Fe River: that has its own contest.)

Prizes: \$300 First Prize

\$50 winner from *within* the Suwannee River Basin.

\$50 winner from *outside*.

One plaque per musical genre.



Where: Turner Center Art Park, Valdosta, Georgia

Song Submissions: open April 18, 2022, by online sound files.

Song Selection: by the WWALS Songwriting Contest Committee with input from online voting.

Entry Tickets: available soon.

The Contest: 7-11 PM, August 20, 2022.

Headliners: play. **Judges:** each play.

Finalists: play. **Judges:** pick winners.

Prizes: awarded. **Winners:** play again.
