

**RESOLUTION**

RECOMMENDING APPROVAL TO REMOVE THE WELL HOUSE AT RED TOP MOUNTAIN STATE PARK VIA EXECUTIVE ORDER FROM THE FOLLOWING NAMED PROPERTY, MORE PARTICULARLY IDENTIFIED ON THE ATTACHED "EXHIBIT A".

**Red Top Mountain State Park  
(Well House, BLLIP #26486, 80 square feet)**

**Location**

**Bartow County**

- WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Natural Resources is responsible for the conservation and wise utilization of the State's natural resources and facilities used to manage them; and
- WHEREAS, the Office of the State Archaeologist determined that removing the non-historic well house would not impact the Georgia/National Register of Historic Places; and
- WHEREAS, the age of the well house requires an Executive Order be issued for demolition since the building is over 50 years old; and
- WHEREAS, the Department will seek approval to remove said well house via EXECUTIVE ORDER detailed on "EXHIBIT B"; and
- WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Natural Resources recommends the removal of the well house due to significant deficiencies that compromise safety, functionality, and compliance with current standards; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Georgia Board of Natural Resources concurs in the findings of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources staff and authorizes the Commissioner to request the Governor of the State of Georgia to execute the proposed Executive Order authorizing the demolition of the well house and the appropriate disposal of the debris.
