**EXECUTIVE ORDER**

BY THE GOVERNOR:

- WHEREAS: the Department of Natural Resources operates the facility in Bartow County known as Red Top Mountain State Park for recreation and conservation purposes; and
- WHEREAS: said property contains a structure known as the well house (BLLIP #29026) totaling 80 square feet; and
- WHEREAS: the Office of the State Archaeologist determined the structure is not historic and would not impact the Georgia/National Register of Historic Places if removed; and
- WHEREAS: the Department's staff agree that the structure is no longer needed for Department operations, is in poor condition, and beyond reasonable repair; and
- WHEREAS: the Board of Natural Resources approved the removal of the structure on January 30, 2026; and
- WHEREAS: the structure has been declared to have no value to the Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA BY VIRTUE OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA, ANNOTATED 50-16-61, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That the Department of Natural Resources is hereby authorized and directed to provide for the demolition and disposal of the aforesaid structure under terms and conditions which are in the best interest of the State of Georgia.
